

What Should Jesus Do?

Write down on various pieces of card, scenarios of different decisions Jesus made him his life.

1. Mary discovers she is pregnant, but not from her husband. What should Jesus do?
2. Jesus spends 40 days without eating and is then offered bread if he will follow Satan. What should Jesus do?
3. Jesus goes to Jerusalem and discovers people at the temple making money at the expense of the poor, what should Jesus do?
4. Jesus has been helping people all day and is now tired and getting ready to sleep when a whole village goes looking for him because they need his help. What should Jesus do?
5. Jesus best friend and cousin is put in prison for telling a King the truth. What should Jesus do?
6. A man with a contagious skin disease reaches out to Jesus. What should Jesus do?
7. A violent man, who is naked and strong enough to break the chains he was bound by, runs towards Jesus shouting at him. What should Jesus do?
8. Jesus' brothers and sister stop believing in him. What should Jesus do?
9. Soldiers are coming to arrest Jesus, and his followers are ready to defend him. What should Jesus do?
10. Jesus has the option to save his life by denying who he is and his life purpose

You can run this activity in several different ways.

1. Nominate a different person in the class to answer a different question each time.
2. Read the questions out loud and give two possible choices. Have the class cheer and clap for the choice they would like to take. Make a class decision based on the loudest cheer.
3. Have each individual take it as a quiz, then share what actually happened. The person with the most correct answers at the end, wins.
4. Have a "Jesus beard." A fake beard that individuals put on when they come to the front of the class and 'pretend' to be Jesus, saying, "I'm Jesus and this is what I would do."
